## Abutilon “Lucky Lantern” Series

This series of new compact generic dwarf Abutilons are a complete breeding breakthrough. They have a tight rounded habit, providing perfect support for the outward faced bell shaped flowers. They are quick and easy to grow; needing one pinch of the central stem which will establish the bushy habit, and no further pinching is required. Another point of interest is the quick finish time; from a 72 cell pack to a quart planted in spring takes just 6-8 weeks. The Abutilons have masses of buds and flowers; this has the added advantage of the plants giving a long retail shelf life. With the flowers giving superb coverage of color and having a long blooming season these Abutilons are sure winners. These plants are ideal for many gardening uses and applications. For the future is a stunning bright red which is soon to be added to the series. Watch out for this one so that you can add to the series.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 8. (15°F or -12°C).

**Foliage:** Small-medium sized mid green foliage.

**Habit:** Compact tight rounded habit. 12" x 12".

**Culture:** Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.



**Abutilon Lucky Lantern ‘Tangerine’ Bloom:** Large bell shaped blooms in warm coral peach tones.

**Abutilon Lucky Lantern ‘White’ Bloom:** Large bell shaped blooms in a pure white tone.

## *Agapanthus 'Gold Strike'*

This colorful New Zealand selection has fantastic golden and green variegated foliage, topped from mid summer with dainty flower heads made up of deep blue buds opening to elegant picotee blue and white striped individual blooms.

'**Gold Strike**' has wider leaves than other variegated Agapanthus with distinct bright and stable gold margins making a bold statement. A striking specimen, excellent for mass planting in the border with multi-season interest even when not in bloom. A great landscape accent plant.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zones 7-10.

**Bloom:** Dainty flower heads made up of deep blue buds opening to elegant picotee blue and white striped blooms.

**Foliage:** Fantastic gold and green variegated foliage.

**Habit:** Tidy small - medium sized clumping habit. 16" x 16". Flower stem 24".

**Culture:** Best grown in fertile soil in full sun to part shade.



## *Colocasia 'Diamond Head'*

This top performer from the sensational Royal Hawaiian® Colocasia collection boasts foliage of deep plum-purple to chocolate-black color with a glossy sheen and ruffled edges. Deep purple leaves and stems reflect light and shimmer in the summer sun. This variety grows in a nice, mannerly clump up to 4 or 5 feet tall. Leaves will reach 12 to 18 inches across, and they don't fall over in mid-summer like so many other varieties. Colocasias are well suited to a tropical program and with their tidy clumping habit they would be a welcome addition in any garden or landscape.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zones 7b - 11; frost will trigger dormancy.

**Foliage:** Bold and beautiful.

**Habit:** Height ranges from 48" - 60".

**Culture:** Full sun for best color. They prefer rich, moist soil.

Colocasia like wet feet. Burnt leaf edges can be a sign of under-watering. Colocasias prefer warm temperatures. The warmer the better for fast growth.

## **NEW** *Cordyline 'Design-A-Line Burgundy'*

This striking new Cordyline selection has fine burgundy weeping foliage with a tight clump-forming habit normally associated with Phormium and New Zealand Flax. The brilliant foliage is more rigid in the pot than other forms. This quick-growing variety makes a striking impulse plant with a long period of seasonal interest. Great in the garden or as a potted specimen plant. This plant offers good performance year around. It keeps it's color and is tidy of habit with great foliage and a scented flower.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zones 8-11, (10°F or -12°C).

**Foliage:** Fine burgundy colored weeping foliage.

**Bloom:** Fragrant jasmine scented sprays of tiny white star shaped blooms. Mid-late summer.

**Habit:** Tight clumping habit. 3' x 3'.

**Culture:** Well-drained soil in full sun to part shade.





## *Cordyline 'Renegade'*

**Cordyline 'Renegade'** is a striking, unique, new clump-forming Cordyline. This variety is set apart from standard Cordyline selections by its tight, clump-forming habit. The broad, dark purple-black foliage is accented with a glossy lacquered finish. **Habit:** Tight clumping habit. Height: 4-7"; Spread: 8".

## *Euphorbia 'Ruby Glow'*

'**Ruby Glow**' has a great habit, is very branched and compact with stunning ruby red foliage in the fall and virtually black leaves in winter in the UK. New foliage is an attractive red. In late March through May, the 18" tall clumps are topped with 6" tall x 3" wide alien antennae-like flower heads of bright yellow. '**Ruby Glow**' can be used as an ornamental plant in gardens and containers for its eye-catching appearance and flowers. As with most Euphorbias, good drainage is very important and be sure to cut the plant back hard after flowering to rejuvenate the new basal growth. '**Ruby Glow**' is a striking impulse plant with a long period of seasonal interest.

**Hardiness:** Zones 6-11. (-10°F or -23°C).

**Bloom:** Masses of fresh apple green bracts. Early summer - fall.

**Foliage:** Unique ruby red new foliage with contrasting bright cherry red stems.

**Habit:** Squat compact-spreading habit. 16" x 20".

**Culture:** Well-drained soil in full sun.

## *Gaura 'Passionate Rainbow Petite'*

'**Passionate Rainbow Petite**' is quicker growing than 'Passionate Rainbow' with a tighter growing dense compact mounding habit. The strong cream/green variegation is highlighted by stunning pink flowers which are massed over many months. The foliage color turns a truly amazing burgundy/red through the cooler months and makes a stunning display even when not in flower. Excellent garden performance with an exceptionally long flowering period.

'**Passionate Rainbow Petite**' is better for small pots with excellent shelf life on the retail bench and does not get tall and unsightly. Drought tolerant once established, and ideal for the landscape, containers, beds, and borders.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 7. (-0°F or -17°C).

**Bloom:** Dark pink bud opening to medium pink blooms. Early summer – fall.

**Foliage:** Mid green foliage with a fine cream margin blush pink-red early in the season, held on hot red stem.

**Habit:** Tightest growing compact mounding habit 18" x 20".

**Culture:** Full sun, well-drained soil.



## *Geranium 'Crystal Rose'*

'**Crystal Rose**' exhibits all the long-blooming and carpeting characteristics of the parent plant 'Westray'. The near-sterile flowers, which are bright and good sized, are long lasting and profuse appearing throughout the year with the main flush in the warmer months. They are held erect above the foliage, which achieves a moderately dense 12-inch diameter during the first growing season. '**Crystal Rose**' is a versatile landscape plant, worthy of inclusion in the border, or in a rock garden or ground cover situation. Ideal for frost prone areas and also performs well in light shade. '**Crystal Rose**' is drought tolerant once established and requires only occasional good soaks during periods of long hot weather.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zones 5-9.

**Bloom:** Strong, mid-pink flowers on stems of 8-10". Near-sterile.

**Foliage:** Dense, semi-evergreen, with an orangey tint in the fall.

**Habit:** 12" x 12".

**Culture:** Tolerates dry conditions, full sun to partial shade.





## **NEW** *Phormium 'Jubilee'*

**Phormium 'Jubilee'** is a New Zealand Flax cultivar that grows to 3'. Long arching upright leaves have a green center and striking cherry red foliage margins on the upper surface and are entirely red below. **'Jubilee'** displays a very interesting stronger color combination than the parent plant, P. 'Jester'. Plants will exhibit best color when grown in part shade and fed weekly with a well balanced fertilizer high in trace element. It can tolerate fairly dry conditions (coastal) but looks best with occasional to regular irrigation. Excellent impulse line.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 8. (15°F or -12°C).

**Bloom:** Foliage selection. No bloom recorded to date.

**Foliage:** Striking cherry red foliage margins to the fresh green foliage.

**Habit:** Tight clumping habit. Foliage is upright-arching. 48" x 72".

**Culture:** Best grown in part shade in fertile soil.



## **NEW** *Sedum 'Elsie's Gold'*

A total show stopper! **Sedum 'Elsie's Gold'** is a beautiful light yellow and green sport from 'Herbstfreude' (Autumn Joy). Attractive toothed silvery green foliage with warm golden yellow leaf margins, fading to a soft creamy white by autumn. By far the most important attribute of **'Elsie's Gold'** is that it is much more stable than the other variegated sedums in commerce. Large flat heads of small star shaped flowers open soft shell pink aging to deep magenta by late autumn. Dried flower heads are excellent for winter garden accents or dried bouquets. Ideal in the stylish modern garden border. **'Elsie's Gold'** is winter hardy.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 3-9. (40°F or -40°C).

**Bloom:** Soft shell pink aging to deep magenta. Long summer – fall blooming period.

**Foliage:** Large toothed foliage with warm golden yellow leaf margins, fading to a soft creamy white by fall.

**Habit:** Compact clump forming habit 12" x 12".

**Culture:** Full sun, well-drained soil.



## **NEW** *Tibouchina 'Groovy Baby'*

This compact genetic dwarf has been selected as part of a breeding program and has been bred for long flowering season and exceptional flower power. Masses of red buds opening to large single vibrant violet blooms. Flowers are larger in size and number and exceptionally outward facing, which makes it a high impact plant at retail. Plant habit is very compact and dense. High cutting yield. All of the above combined with more cold tolerance than normal Tibouchina. Heat and drought tolerant once established. Great for containers, borders and the modern landscape.

**Hardiness:** Zone 10. (35°F or -1°C).

**Bloom:** Large single vibrant violet blooms with masses of red buds. Summer-fall. (Long Blooming Season).

**Foliage:** Small sized ribbed foliage.

**Habit:** Extremely compact rounded habit. 1.5' x 1.5'.

**Culture:** Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun. Trim back when young and after blooming to encourage strong basal branching and re-blooming.

# PlantHaven Shrub Program



PlantHaven is pleased to launch five outstanding Berberis varieties from Michal Andrusiv in the Czech Republic. All five varieties have been trialed extensively throughout the U.S. and have performed exceptionally well in all climate zones. As with all new barberries, the varieties were held in quarantine for wheat rust testing at the USDA Cereal Disease Laboratory in Minnesota for more than 2 years and were found to be rust resistant.



**Berberis 'Admiration'**

**Berberis Admiration:** Vibrant flaming coral-red foliage with bright golden yellow leaf margin. Compact rounding habit 1-2' x 1-2' in 5 years (ultimately 2' x 2' untrimmed).

**Berberis Golden Rocket:** Fresh chartreuse foliage with contrasting coral colored stems. Unique tight columnar habit, ultimately 4' in H.

**Berberis Orange Rocket:** Vibrant coral-orange new foliage aging to mid green. Best foliage color when grown in full sun. Unique tight columnar habit, ultimately 4' H.

**Berberis Rosy Rocket:** Fine new young foliage is variegated in soft flamingo pink and burgundy tones held on slender coral stem giving a firework like effect. Tight columnar habit, ultimately 4' H.

**Berberis Tiny Gold:** Bright sunshine yellow foliage. Tight compact rounded habit. 1-2' x 1-2' in 5 years (Ultimately 2' x 2' untrimmed).

# PlantHaven Trees

## *Cercis 'Merlot'*

'Merlot' is a *Canadensis* and *texensis* cross to produce a more drought and heat tolerant tree. It has glossy, small rounded dark purple leaves and has an upright vase shaped growth habit. It has a tighter, denser habit than *Cercis 'Forest Pansy'* and is more heat tolerant and drought tolerant (*texensis* factor.) Mature plants flower heavily with strong bright pink flowers that are self-cleaning, and have a low seed set. 'Merlot' does not show leaf stress in heat.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).

**Bloom:** Reddish-purple flowers borne on bare stems in early spring.

**Foliage:** Deciduous, large rounded glossy dark purple foliage.

**Habit:** Semi-upright vase shaped habit. 12' x 15'. The perfect tree for small yards.

**Culture:** Best grown in full sun in well drained soils.



## *Cercis 'Ruby Falls'*

*Cercis 'Ruby Falls'* is a highly attractive weeping form of *Cercis canadensis* with large heart shaped purple leaves. It is the first weeping purple redbud developed. It has attractive dark rose purple flowers. 'Ruby Falls' demonstrates excellent branching with a full crown of foliage at the top. It is an excellent small tree for lawns, as a garden specimen, for woodland gardens or naturalized areas and landscape plantings. 'Ruby Falls' is effective planted as a specimen or in groups. Requires minimal pruning.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).

**Bloom:** Intermediate reddish-purple flowers borne on bare stems in early spring. Profuse flowering and low pod set.

**Foliage:** Deciduous, large heart shaped deep purple foliage.

**Habit:** Elegant weeping habit. 6' x 4'. The perfect weeping tree for small yards.

**Culture:** Best grown in full sun in well drained soils.

'Fragrant Fountain' offers significant improvements over existing weeping snowbells! As compared to 'Carillion', 'Fragrant Fountain' maintains a central leader and is a vigorous grower. Masses of strongly fragrant pure white blooms appear in spring. This selection has tolerated temperature extremes ranging from 115 degrees to no damage from the early frost in Oregon in 2002. It's compact habit makes it the perfect tree for smaller yards.

**Hardiness:** USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).

**Bloom:** Masses of strongly fragrant pure white blooms. Early spring-summer; repeat blooming mid/late summer where conditions are not too dry.

**Foliage:** Deciduous, glossy dark green foliage, coloring to golden yellow in fall.

**Habit:** Vigorous weeping habit. 6' x 5'.

**Culture:** Best grown in sun-part shade in fertile well drained soils.

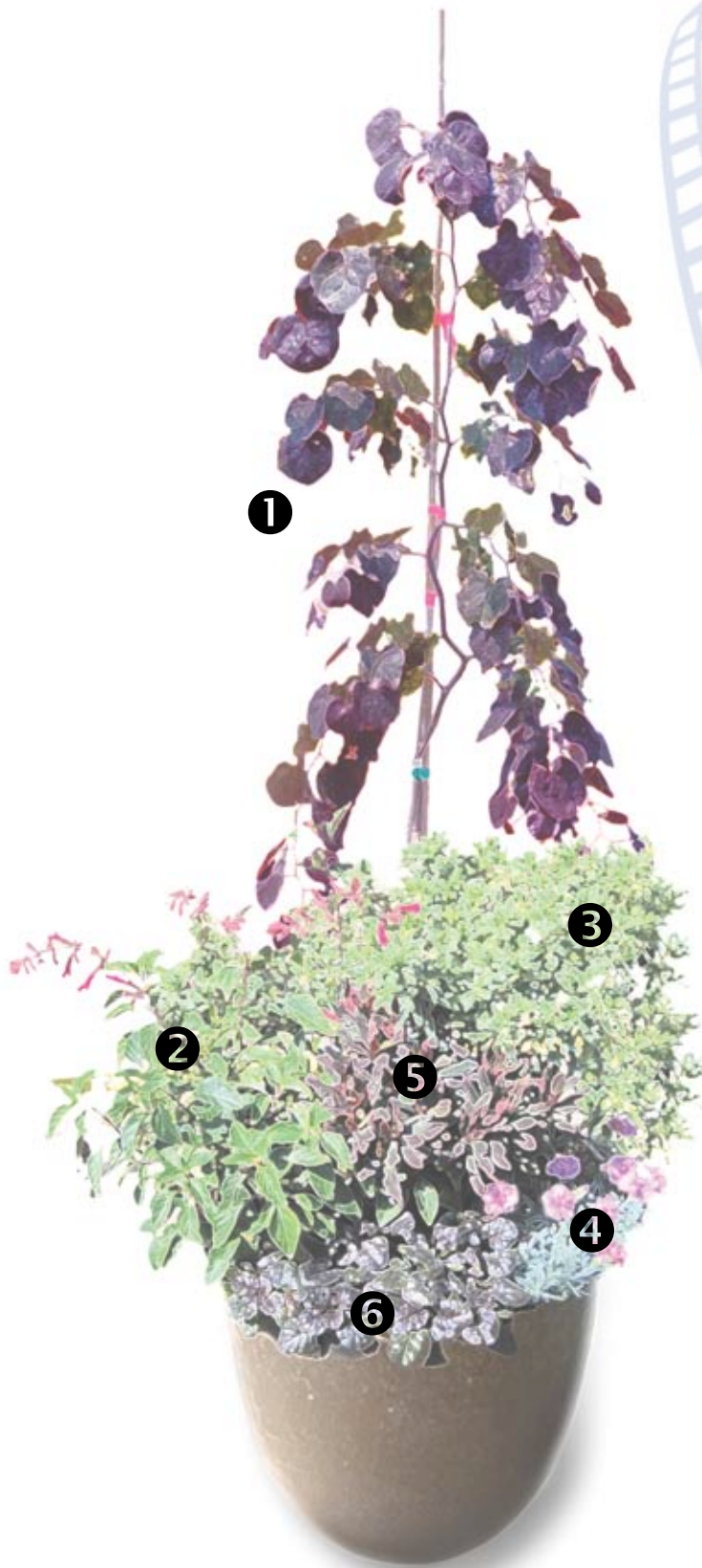

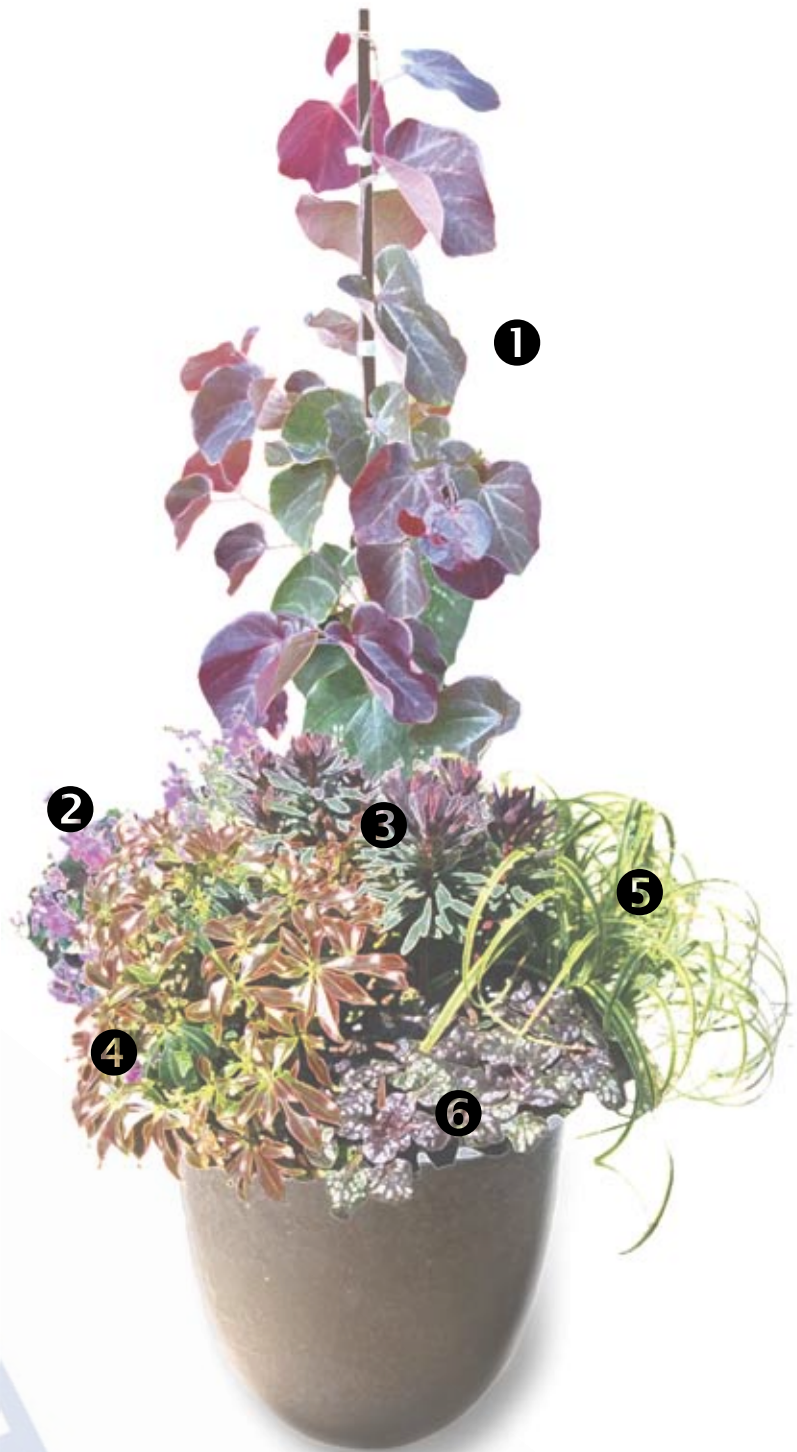
