<b>Bloom Time:</b>	April-September.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Broad golden variegated foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tidy, small-medium, clumping habit. 16" x 16". Flower stem 24".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Easy care, grow in fertile soil in full sun to part shade. Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Specimen, Perennial Border, Pots & Containers.

### **Approximate Finishing Time**

<b>4.5" Quarts:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks</b> from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
<b>6" Gallons:</b>	<b>12-16 weeks</b> from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).

<b>Closest Variety:</b> A. ‘Tinkerbell’	<b>Key Differences:</b> ✓ ‘Gold Strike’ striking broad golden foliage <b>vs.</b> narrow white foliage. ✓ ‘Gold Strike’ masses of blooms <b>vs.</b> shy to bloom. ✓ ‘Gold Strike’ great impact <b>vs.</b> average.
