Habit:	Tidy, small-medium, clumping habit. 16" x 16". Flower stem 24".
Propagation:	Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Easy care, grow in fertile soil in full sun to part shade. Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Specimen, Perennial Border, Pots & Containers.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" Quarts:	10-12 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).
6" Gallons:	12-16 weeks from a 72 plug (Spring Planting).

Closest Variety: A. 'Tinkerbell'	Key Differences: Ü 'Gold Strike' striking broad golden foliage vs. narrow white foliage. Ü 'Gold Strike' masses of blooms vs. shy to bloom. Ü 'Gold Strike' great impact vs. average.
