

CAMPSIS Tango ('Huitan')

Origin: Bred in a Dutch nursery breeding program, Huisman Boomkwekerij B.V.

Species: *Campsis radicans*

Protection Status: US PP# 16,656; EU PBR applied for.

Characteristics:

'**Tango**' is unique because of its many trumpet shaped red flowers. The well-known varieties 'Madam Galen' and 'Indian Summer' are much more orange. All shoots of 'Tango' will yield flowers whereas 40% of the shoots of 'Madam Galen' do not flower the first year. '**Tango**' is more compact than the existing varieties and makes a much improved presentation in the Garden Center. It propagates easily by cuttings. '**Tango**' can be used a climbing vine along a wall, fence or up a trellis.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 6

Bloom: Masses of RED trumpet shaped flowers, all shoots produce blooms.

Foliage: Shiny dark green leaves

Habit: Climbing. Mature height in the US yet to be determined.

Propagation: Rootstock and vegetative cuttings. *License required for propagation*

Culture: Partial shade or partial sun to full sun.
