

## COREOPSIS Flying Saucers ('Walcoreop')

Origin: Bred by English plantsman David Tristram.

Species: *Coreopsis grandiflora*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #10,299, Canadian PBR 1,035; COPF Open

### Characteristics:

'**Flying Saucers**' is a great garden performer. This *Coreopsis* was selected for its uniform plant habit, good vigor, and large abundant yellow flowers which are present throughout the entire flowering season. '**Flying Saucers**' blooms from June until October. When compared to other *Coreopsis grandiflora* cultivars, '**Flying Saucers**' has a more uniform, compact growth habit with better branching, is more vigorous, and blooms longer on stronger flower stems. Wonderful in perennial borders for continuous bloom or highlighted in large containers.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 5-9

Bloom: June-October

Foliage: Dark green.

Habit: Compact, spreading, uniform, 18" tall in bloom.

Propagation: Terminal tip cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Fertile, well-drained soils in full sun to part shade.
