USDA Zone:	Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).
Bloom:	Profusions of deep mauve-blue blooms.
Bloom Time:	Early summer - fall.
Foliage:	Broad fresh zesty two tone lemon-lime foliage.
Habit:	Tidy, compact rounded habit. 24" x 30".
Propagation:	Semi ripe cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Well-drained soil in full sun.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Cut hard back in spring to ensure good branch structure. Holds up well in the heat of the southeast "including a Georgia summer!"
Uses:	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" Quarts:	8-12 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" Gallons:	12-16 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).

 ✓ **Hint of Gold** broad foliage **vs.** narrow foliage.
