

***Cercis* ‘Hearts of Gold’**

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Cercis canadensis</i>
Protection Status:	PP17, 740. COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20 °F or -28 °C).
Bloom:	Clusters of pink-lavender sweet pea like blooms borne on the bare stems in early spring.
Bloom Time:	Early spring.
Foliage:	Deciduous, golden yellow heart shaped foliage. New growth is blushed copper in color.
Habit:	Upright vase to spreading habit. 12' x 15'. The perfect tree for smaller sized yards.
Propagation:	Budding / Grafting & Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in full sun to part shade in moist but well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Burn-resistant foliage even in full sun. Shaded foliage will turn chartreuse-green. Lightly trim as required.
Uses:	Garden Specimen, Hedging & Landscape Plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

5 Gallon:	2 years from a whip (Winter Planting).
15 Gallon:	3 years from a whip (Winter Planting).
