Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Colocasia esculenta</i>
USDA Zone:	Zone 7b-11. (5°F or -14°C).
Bloom:	Foliage selection. Spath/spadix inflorescence.
Foliage:	Lush tropical foliage – see below for full variety descriptions.
Habit:	Tidy, clump forming habit. These selections do not send out runners.
Propagation:	TC / division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Moist soil in full sun to part shade. 50°F nights and 70-80°F (or warmer) days.
Additional Comments:	Excess high nitrogen or drying out can cause foliage burn.
Uses:	Large Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Pool side plantings.

'Blue Hawaii'	Green leaves with purple veins and margin, mate finish, purple petioles. 48" x 24".
'Diamond Head'	Glossy dark purple to black leaves with dark purple petioles. 48" x 24".
'Hawaiian Eye'	Greenish purple leaves with matt finish, burgundy piko, burgundy petioles. 48" x 24".
'Hilo Bay'	Glossy olive green corrugated leaves, dark purple petioles. 48" x 24".
'Pineapple Princess'	Yellow-green leaves with light purple veins and margin, burgundy petioles. 36" x 24".

Approximate Finishing Time

6"- Gallons: 12-16 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
