Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Cornus kousa</i>
Protection Status:	PPAF. COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
Bloom:	Creamy white bracts cover the tree in early spring.
Bloom Time:	Early spring.
Foliage:	Deciduous foliage, mid green with colorful broad golden yellow margins. Foliage blushes soft flamingo pink transforming to a fabulous flaming red by fall.
Habit:	Tidy rounded habit 8' x 4'.
Propagation:	Budding / Grafting. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in part shade with adequate moisture in well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Irrigate well in summer / drought conditions. Lightly trim as required.
Uses:	Garden Specimen, Landscape Plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

5 Gallon:	2 years from a whip (Winter Planting).
15 Gallon:	3 years from a whip (Winter Planting).
