### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Daphne x transatlantica</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP 18,361; COFP Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 6. (-10°F or -23°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Profusions of tight heads of soft pink buds opening to pure white intensely scented blooms.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early spring followed by constant succession from summer to fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Semi-Evergreen, mid green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Excellent tight, rounded, compact habit 2' x 2' in 4 years. (Ultimately 3' x 3').
<b>Propagation:</b>	Semi ripe Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best in full sun in a semi slightly acidic soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Test result show great heat and humidity tolerance.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, garden specimen, mass landscape planting.
