Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Dianthus hybrida</i>
Protection Status:	PP13,914; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Fragrant double blooms, pearl pink in color, carried on sturdy stems. Repeat blooming.
Bloom Period:	Early season – Fall.
Foliage:	Glaucous, blue green foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 14-18" x 10-14".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	No vernalization required for blooming. Flower stems are sturdy and do not flop. Dead headed and fed regularly to encourage fast repeat blooming. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting, Cut Flower.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	8-10 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	10-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
