

## *Digitalis Goldcrest* ('WALDIGONE')

### Key Features

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Digitalis grandiflora x obscura</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	USPP 20937; COFP Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Sterile uniquely colored peach to apricot blooms with peach to red blush.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Early summer - fall. (Long flowering season).
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deep green semi-evergreen foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 18" x 12".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tissue Culture / Division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun to part shade, in fertile well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Trim hard back in spring to encourage strong new basal growth.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>4.5" - Quarts:</b>	<b>4-6 weeks</b> from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
<b>6" - Gallons:</b>	<b>8-10 weeks</b> from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
