

ERYSIMUM 'Fragrant Sunshine'

Origin: Bred by English plant breeder David Tristram of Walberton Nursery.

Species: *Erysimum hybrid*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #13,432; Canadian PBR Pending

Characteristics:

'Fragrant Sunshine' is compact & bushy, with bright yellow blooms from April to July. Being sterile, flowering may continue to October. Flowers are sweetly scented and buds arise chocolate-purple in color. Recommended uses of 'Fragrant Sunshine' include landscape or container specimen, rock gardens, and perennial borders. May also be used as a large annual in northern climates.

Hardiness: USDA zones 7-10

Bloom: Full flower impact from April to July, with bright yellow flowers. Sporadic blooming may continue to October. Flowers have a strong, sweet fragrance.

Foliage: Deep green with a silver sheen.

Habit: Compact and bushy, with a height of 1.5' by 2' wide.

Propagation: Soft cuttings and tissue culture. *License required to propagate.*

Culture: Full sun, partial shade, in well-draining semi-alkaline soil.
