

## EUPHORBIA 'Blue Haze'

Origin: Bred by English Plantsman Robin White.

Species: *Euphorbia nicaiana* x *nicaeensis*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #14,868; Canadian PBR Pending; COPF Open

### Characteristics:

'Blue Haze' was selected by the inventor for its powder-blue foliage and contrasting yellow-green/soft yellow flowers. 'Blue Haze' is a glaucous-blue foliated plant with red-tinted stems. The yellow flower bracts emerge in mid spring. Due to the compact growth and semi-spreading habit, 'Blue Haze' is ideal as mixed patio containers, a garden accent plant or as the front of the perennial border.

Hardiness: Zones 7-9.

Bloom: Yellow flower bracts emerge in mid spring, with soft-yellow flowers in summer.

Foliage: Powder-blue glaucous foliage with pink tints during cooler temperatures.

Habit: Vigorous, semi-spreading and compact, mature height is 12-18" by 18-24" wide.

Propagation: Tissue culture and cuttings. *License required to propagate.*

Culture: Full sun and well drained soil.
