Characteristics

Genus & Species:	<i>Erysimum hybrida</i>
Protection Status:	PP13,432; COFP Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 7. (-0°F or -17°C).
Bloom:	Bright sunshine yellow sweetly scented sterile bloom.
Bloom Period:	Early spring - summer. (Long Flowering season).
Foliage:	Deep green foliage.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 24".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun to part shade, in fertile well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Trim hard back in spring to encourage strong basal branching.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-10 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).

Closest Variety: *E.* 'Bowls Mauve' **Key Differences:** ✓ **Fragrant Sunshine** sunshine yellow blooms **vs.** mauve blooms.
 ✓ **Fragrant Sunshine** masses of blooms **vs.** medium-light blooms.
 ✓ **Fragrant Sunshine** long flowering period **vs.** short-medium.
