<b>Bloom:</b>	Masses of cream, blue-green & red colorful bracts.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early summer - fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Colorful cream-golden yellow & blue-green variegated foliage, blushed pink in cooler temperatures.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact bushy habit. 20" x 20".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Well-drained soil in full sun.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape.
