<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	Gaillardia x <i>grandiflora</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP 17,092; COFP Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 5-9. (-20°F or -28°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Masses of soft orange and lemon yellow single blooms.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Early summers – fall.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Medium green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Compact mounding habit 24" x 18"
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings / Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Test result show great heat and humidity tolerance.
<b>Uses:</b>	Beds, borders, mass Landscape.

## Approximate Finishing Time

<b>4.5" - Quarts:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>6" - Gallons:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).</b>

**Closest Variety:** G. ‘Goblin’

 ✓ ‘Oranges and Lemons’ medium-tall habit **vs.** small-medium habit.  
 ✓ ‘Oranges and Lemons’ long flowering period **vs.** short-medium.
