Bloom Period:	Early summers – fall.
Foliage:	Mid green foliage with a cream edge blush rosy red.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 20".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Bijou Pronounced: bee-zhoo is the French word for small & beautifully formed. Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-10 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
