G. Pink Fountain (*'Walgaupf'*) PP15,555 & **Snow Fountain** (*'Walsnofou'*) PP19,376.

Key Features

- ✓ Masses of soft pink and white blooms.
- ✓ Heavy lateral branching giving a dense plant habit.
- ✓ Exceptionally long flowering period. Great for the commercial landscape.

Genus & Species:	<i>Gaura lindheimeri</i>
Protection Status:	PP Granted or Pending; COFP Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20°F or -28°C).
Bloom:	Profusions of soft pink and white blooms.
Bloom Period:	Early summers – fall.
Foliage:	Mid green foliage.
Habit:	Dense compact mounding habit 24" x 24".
Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-10 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
