Culture:	Full sun – partial shade, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

4.5" - Quarts:	8-10 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	10-12 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
