

HEUCHERA Canyon Quartet Series

Origin: Bred in a Heuchera breeding program at the Santa Barbara Botanic Gardens by the late Dara Emery.

Species: *Heuchera hybrid*

Protection Status: '**Canyon Belle**' US PP #13,413; '**Canyon Chimes**' US PP# 13,281; '**Canyon Duet**' US PP #13,280; '**Canyon Melody**' US PP# 13,276; COPF Open.

Characteristics:

The **Canyon Series Heuchera** were bred for a dwarf mounding habit and show proportional flowers. Flower power and color, not foliage was the goal of this breeder. Several colors including pink, red, light pink and a bi-color pink on white. The **Canyon Quartet** is ideal for finished product of gallon pot or smaller. Use in rock garden, small area ground cover, edging plant, or as a mixed container specimen.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 4.

Bloom: '**Canyon Belle**'-Red; '**Canyon Chimes**'-Dark pink; '**Canyon Duet**'-Pink and white; '**Canyon Melody**'-Medium pink calyces, white petals.

Foliage: Small, dark green foliage from rosettes.

Habit: 12-18" in bloom, foliage mounds to 4" and spreads to 12"

Propagation: Cuttings and division. Very easy to propagate, TC not required. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Partial shade with regular water, loamy soil.
