

## HEUCHERA 'Crimson Curls'

Origin: Bred by English plant breeder Ray Brown of Plant World Nursery.

Species: *Heuchera hybrid*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #13,729. COPF Open.

### Characteristics:

Heuchera '**Crimson Curls**' has distinctively, unusually curly, crimson foliage. The crimson color is particularly intense in the spring and is retained well if grown in soils that are not too rich. The airy, white flowers on burgundy stems are very attractive with this foliage. Dramatic when grown as a specimen or en masse.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 3.

Bloom: White blooms on burgundy stems in summer.

Foliage: Burgundy ruffles with brighter crimson undersides.

Habit: Mounded, compact clumps. 18" tall, 15" wide.

Propagation: Tissue culture and division. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Moist, well-drained soils in partial shade are preferred. Full sun, if moist soil.
