Propagation:	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Tolerant of mildew. Drought tolerant once established.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

4.5"- Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-10 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (Spring Planting).
