Key Features

- Ü Vigorous grower.
- Ü Early season flowering. Masses of large ivory – white blooms.
- Ü Exceptionally long flowering period. Great garden performance.

Genus & Species:	<i>Helleborus xhybridus</i>
Protection Status:	PP16,199; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 4. (-30°F or -34.4°C).
Bloom:	Large ivory-white blooms blushed apple green, antiquing to pink & mid green in color.
Bloom Period:	Very spring (Feb) - summer.
Foliage:	Robust green-grey foliage with pale veining.
Habit:	Compact mounding habit 18" x 20".
Propagation:	100% Tissue Culture. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade, moist well fertilized soil.
Additional Comments:	Top dress with slow release fertilizer in early spring.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	26-28 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Fall planting for early Feb sales).
6" - Gallons:	30-32 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Summer planting for early Feb sales).

Closest Variety: *H. niger*

Key Differences: Ü **Ivory Prince** early season **vs.** mid-late season.
 Ü **Ivory Prince** masses of bloom **vs.** light-medium bloom number.
 Ü **Ivory Prince** long flowering period **vs.** short-medium period.
