Key Features

Characteristics

Genus & Species:	Hosta fluctuans
Protection Status:	PP12,531; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -39°C).
Bloom:	Arching sprays of funnel shaped pale lavender flowers.
Bloom Period:	Mid summer.
Foliage:	Glaucous green centers with irregular colorful broad yellow leaf margins. Yellow and lightens to cream through the season. Heavy leaf substance undulating with age.
Habit:	Upright vase-shaped growth habit 42" x 42".
Propagation:	Tissue culture and division. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Moist soils in light to full shade.
Additional Comments:	Sport from H. 'Sagae', formerly H. fluctuans 'Variegated'.
Uses:	Shade Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	6-8 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	8-12 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (spring planting).

Closest Variety: H. 'Sagae'

Key Differences:

- ✓ 'Liberty' broader yellow leaf margins **vs.** narrower leaf margins.
- ✓ 'Liberty' brighter appearance **vs.** more subdued appearance.
- ✓ 'Liberty' great garden presence **vs.** average garden presence.
