

## KNIPHOFIA 'Peachy Cheeks'

Origin: A colorful sport of Kniphofia 'Little Maid' selected at Lyndale Nurseries, Auckland, New Zealand.

Species: Kniphofia hybrid

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #20,313

### Characteristics:

This colorful sport of Kniphofia 'Little Maid' has fantastic dwarf, almost grass-like foliage just like the parent but is topped from mid summer with profusion of delicate peach blushed soft yellow 'pokers' aging to cream. Great for mass planting at the front of the border or for pot work. A great addition to the easy care, late summer border. Hardy. 0.6 x 0.25m.

Hardiness: Hardy (USDA Zone 7 - 9)

Bloom: Delicate peach blushed soft yellow 'pokers'

Foliage: Fantastic dwarf, almost grass-like foliage

Habit: Compact rounded habit, 0.60 x 0.25m

Propagation: TC & division.

Culture: Fertile well-drained soils in sun or part shade. Feed regularly to maintain performance. Trim back hard in spring to encourage new growth.
