

## Koelreuteria ‘Coral Sun’

### Characteristics

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP17,409; COPF open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 6b. (-5°F or -20°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	No blooms observed in 10 years of trials.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	N/A.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deciduous cut foliage. New spring growth in striking coral-flamingo pink in color before ageing to mid green. Contrasting well with the bright coral colored stems.
<b>Habit:</b>	Round mushroom shape. 6' x 5' in 5 years. (Ultimately 30' x 30' Untrimmed).
<b>Propagation:</b>	Soft wood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in full sun in moist well drained soils.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established.
<b>Uses:</b>	Ornamental Small Tree, Garden Specimen, Hedging.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>1 Gallon:</b>	<b>12 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>2 Gallon:</b>	<b>24 months from a 2.5" liner (Spring Planting).</b>

**Closest Variety:** *K. paniculata*    **Key Differences:** ✓ ‘Coral Sun’ long foliage interest period **vs.** average interest period.  
 ✓ ‘Coral Sun’ bring coral stem **vs.** green stems.  
 ✓ ‘Coral Sun’ no flowers observed in 10years **vs.** flowers observed
