

LAVANDULA Silver Edge ('Walvera')

Origin: Bred by English breeders David Tristram and Tim Crowther of Walberton Nursery.

Species: *Lavandula x intermedia*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #13.091. Canadian PBR.

Characteristics:

'**Silver Edge**' has stable variegated foliage with blue green centers and creamy to white clean margins. It is a vigorous grower with a tight habit and upright blooms. Blooms are a blue violet and arise in July and August. Use '**Silver Edge**' as a garden specimen, herb garden, or in a container.

Hardiness: USDA zone 6

Bloom: 40" tall in bloom and about 23" in spread (mature plants).

Foliage: Stable variegation of blue-green centers and a creamy white margin.

Habit: Tight mound with upright flowers.

Propagation: Tissue culture, cuttings and division. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Well-drained soils in full sun.
