

## LAVATERA 'Red Rum'

Origin: Bred by English plant breeder Ken Rigney.

Species: *Lavatera hybrid*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #13,898

### Characteristics:

'Red Rum' is a compact grower great for containers or a mid-level plant in a perennial bed. Dark red stems hold closely packed red-pink flowers. The close clustering of the flowers makes an intense floral display. Named after the multi-race award winning British racehorse, *Red Rum*.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 6-9

Bloom: Spring bloomer in a red-pink color. Very floriferous on dark red stems.

Foliage: Green.

Habit: Up to 4' in height.

Propagation: Cuttings. *License required to propagate.*

Culture: Similar to other cultivars. Full sun.
