Foliage:	Bright silver foliage with deep green outer margin.
Habit:	Compact mat formings habit 4-6" x 12-16".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun – partial shade. Tolerant of most soils.
Additional Comments:	Easy Care. Drought tolerant once established. Exhibits good resistance to leaf spot.
Uses:	Containers, Beds, Borders, Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	4-6 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	6-8 weeks from a 128 cell transplant (spring planting).
