

LAVANDULA from New Zealand

Origin: Bred by New Zealand lavender specialist Virginia McNaughton of Lavender Downs, Ltd.

Species: *Lavandula dentata*, *stoechas*, *angustifolia*.

Protection Status: '**Lumiere**' US PP# 15,209; '**Passionne**' US PP# 15,208; '**Serenity**' US PP#14,510; '**Granny's Bouquet**' US PP# 15,206; '**Violet Intrigue**' US PP# 15,344. Canadian PBR Pending.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 8

Bloom: Profuse flowering in spring through summer.

Foliage: Gray-green, heavily dentate

Habit: Dense, mounding and upright. 2 feet tall and wide.

Propagation: Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun in well-drained soil.
