

## PHYGELIUS “Croftway Series”

Origin: Bred by English plant breeder Malcolm Spencer

Species: *Phygелиus x rectus*

Protection Status: ‘Purple Prince’, US PP #18,540; ‘Yellow Sovereign’, US PP #18,376; ‘Coral Princess’: US PP #18,601; ‘Snow Queen’: US PP #18,366. COPF Open.

### Characteristics:

A new series of compact, long-blooming *Phygелиus* from the United Kingdom. These showy perennials provide color summer to frost. Tubular flowers are pendulous and loosely clustered on sturdy stems. Nectar attracts hummingbirds. Plants mature at 24-36” in the landscape, and cover a range of colors, including the first truly white *Phygелиus*. They are all uniform size and growth, with denser flower spikes and stronger stems than other cultivars, making them good candidates for gallon container production.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 7

Bloom: Spring thru summer, uniformly presented pendulous flowers.

Foliage: Dark green with sturdy stems.

Habit: Height is 10 - 14" and width is 14 - 18", overall compact growers.

Propagation: Cuttings. *License required for propagation.*

Culture: Full sun and well-drained soil.
