

## ROSA Pink Above All ('Chewpearl')

Origin: Bred by Chris Warner, Professional UK Rose Breeder.

Species: *Rosa hybrids*

Protection Status: US Plant Patent #13,877

### Characteristics:

'**Pink Above All**' is a vigorous climbing rose that is easy to train. Blooming profusely from spring through fall, its small satin-pink flowers contrast against dark green, glossy foliage. Its re-blooming is its most important feature as it is continual without rest periods. Bred for disease resistance, and strength of growth on its own roots, '**Pink Above All**' is a much quicker rose to finish! Production is already established at Greenheart, where plugs can be purchased. Throw one in a gallon for finish in a year, or transplant that year to a 3 gallon for a greater selling price the following year. '**Pink Above All**' was the winner of the Bronze Medal at the 2001 Buenos Aires Rose Trial. '**Pink Above All**' is ideally used climbing a wall, fence or trellis and can be trained into an espalier for a spectacular "Wall of Roses". In the garden center its early blooming quality in a small pot (one gallon) will make it a popular impulse buy.

Hardiness: USDA Zone 6

Bloom: Profuse flowers from late spring until first frost. Satin pink and last 6 to 10 days.

Foliage: Small, glossy, dark green leaves. Proven disease resistant for five years in California.

Habit: Climbing.

Culture: Full sun, moist well-drained soil.
