Bloom:	Clusters of deep pink blooms.
Bloom Period:	Summer – fall.
Foliage:	Coral orange-red tips re-flushing the entire season on bright golden yellow foliage.
Habit:	Tight compact mounding habit 12" x 12".
Propagation:	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Full sun, well-drained soil.
Additional Comments:	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies.
Uses:	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

Approximate Finishing Time

4.5" - Quarts:	8-12 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).
6" - Gallons:	12-16 weeks from a 128 plug (spring planting).

Closest Variety: S. 'Gold Mound'

Ü **Magic Carpet** well branched **vs.** average.
Ü **Magic Carpet** orange-red tips **vs.** orange tips.
