Genus & Species:	<i>Styrax japonicus</i>
Protection Status:	PP19,664; COPF Open.
USDA Zone:	USDA Zone 5. (-20 °F or -28 °C).
Bloom:	Masses of strongly fragrant pure white blooms.
Bloom Time:	Early spring-summer; repeat blooming mid/late summer where conditions are not too dry.
Foliage:	Deciduous, glossy dark green foliage, coloring to golden yellow in fall.
Habit:	Vigorous weeping habit. 6' x 5'.
Propagation:	Budding / Grafting. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
Culture:	Best grown in sun-part shade in fertile well drained soils.
Additional Comments:	Best in Show – Farwest 2008. The perfect tree for smaller sized yards. Irrigate well in summer / drought conditions.
Uses:	Garden Specimen, Street Trees, Landscape Plantings.

Approximate Finishing Time

5 Gallon:	2 years from a whip (Winter Planting).
15 Gallon:	3 years from a whip (Winter Planting).

Closest Variety: <i>S.</i> 'Carillion' Key Differences: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' significantly more blooms vs. average bloom. ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' strong central leader vs. needs training. ✓ 'Fragrant Fountain' tolerant of extreme temperatures vs. less tolerant.
