

## **Verbena ‘Little One’**

### **Key Features**

- ✓ Compact genetic dwarf.
- ✓ Elegant hazy flower spikes of deep purple blooms.
- ✓ No seed observed in 3 years of trials.

### **Characteristics**

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Verbena bonariensis</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP18,124; COPF Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	Zone 7-10. (0°F or -18°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Elegant hazy flower spikes of deep purple blooms.
<b>Bloom Time:</b>	Summer-fall. (Long Blooming Season)
<b>Foliage:</b>	Toothed mid green foliage.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight bushy habit. 18" x 10". (Ultimately 2' x 18").
<b>Propagation:</b>	Softwood cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Best grown in well-drained soil in full sun.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Heat & drought tolerant once established. Trim back when young & after blooming to encourage strong basal branching & re-blooming.
<b>Uses:</b>	Pots & Containers, Garden Border, Modern landscape.

<b>4.5" Quarts:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).</b>
<b>6" Gallons:</b>	<b>10-12 weeks from a 72 cell transplant (Spring Planting).</b>
