

## ***Veronica Royal Candles*** ('Glory')

### Key Features

- ✓ Abundant spires of deep violet blue blooms.

<b>Genus &amp; Species:</b>	<i>Veronica spicata</i>
<b>Protection Status:</b>	PP18,932; COPF Open.
<b>USDA Zone:</b>	USDA Zone 3. (-40°F or -40°C).
<b>Bloom:</b>	Abundant spires of deep violet blue blooms.
<b>Bloom Period:</b>	Summer.
<b>Foliage:</b>	Deep green foliage. Bottom foliage does not die out unlike other selections.
<b>Habit:</b>	Tight compact clump forming habit 18" x 18".
<b>Propagation:</b>	Tip Cuttings. <i>License required for propagation.</i>
<b>Culture:</b>	Full sun to partial shade, well-drained soil.
<b>Additional Comments:</b>	Drought tolerant once established. Attracts bees and butterflies.
<b>Uses:</b>	Containers, Borders, Mass Landscape Planting.

### Approximate Finishing Time

<b>4.5" - Quarts:</b>	<b>6-8 weeks</b> from a 128 plug (spring planting).
<b>6" - Gallons:</b>	<b>8-12 weeks</b> from a 128 plug (spring planting).

**Closest Variety:** S. 'Sunny Border Blue' **Key Differences:** ✓ 'Royal Candles' compact habit **vs.** medium habit.  
✓ 'Royal Candles' deep violet blue blooms **vs.** violet blue.  
✓ 'Royal Candles' bottom foliage does not die **vs.** regular die back.
